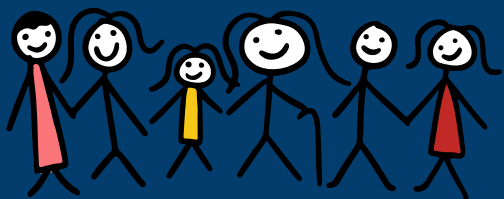

19th August, our school observed the celebration of achievements. The day was a fiesta devoted especially to the graduate and college students.

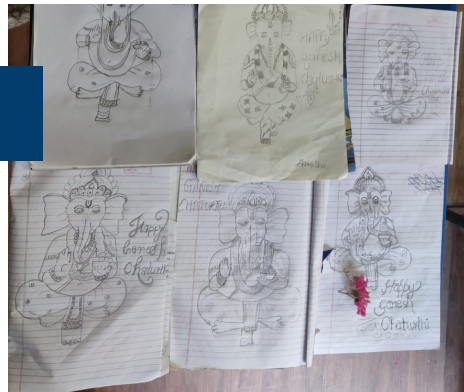
It was a bittersweet feeling to see our dear students, whom we had nurtured for years, leave the school to continue with their life's journey toward higher education.

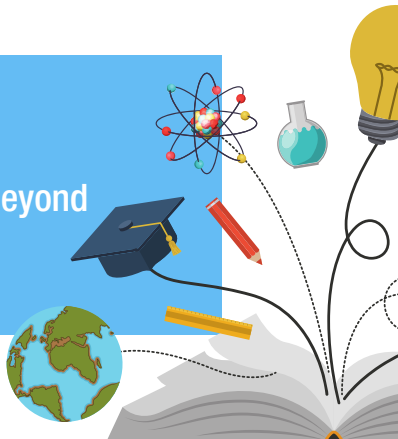
